ORDER

Whereas, all the religious places/institutions of Jajpur District were closed as per orders of Govt. of Odisha since 20.03.2020 and extended from time to time for entry of general public/devotees in view of threat of spread of COVID-19 till date.

Whereas, Govt. of Odisha vide order No.6691/R&DM(DM) Dtd.30.11.2020 of Chief Secretary, Odisha have ordered to reopen more activities in areas outside Containment Zones up to 31.12.2020 wherein District Collectors have been authorised to accord permission for public worship in religious places/places of worship with appropriate restrictions to curb spread of COVID-19,

And Whereas, accordingly, assessment of ground level situation and due consultation with relevant stake holders have been made,

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that all the religious places/institutions of Jajpur District shall be opened to general public/devotees for "Darshan/Worship" with effect from **08.01.2021(Friday)** with strict adherence of following guidelines/exemptions/restrictions to be ensured and maintained by authorities of the concerned religious places/institutions.

1. The religious places/institutions shall remain open for general public/devotees as per the traditionally fixed hours of time maintained and observed in concerned religious places/institutions for Darshan/Worship.
2. It is mandatory for all general public/devotees to wear mask at all times inside and outside the premises of religious places/institutions.
3. General Public/devotees must sanitize their hands before entering into the religious places/institutions.
4. General Public/devotees shall maintain physical distance at all times as per COVID-19 guidelines issued by Govt. of Odisha.
5. General Public/devotees shall not touch statues/idols/monuments inside the religious places/institutions.
6. General Public/devotees having symptoms of Fever, Cough and Cold shall not be allowed to enter inside the religious places/institutions.
7. The "Anna Prasad Kendra" inside the premises of the religious places/institutions, if any, run by concerned authorities earlier, shall remain closed for the time being and any kind



- of community dining is strictly prohibited inside the premises of the religious places/institutions and periphery area.
8. Chewing of Tobacco /Betel(Paan)/Spitting inside premises of religious places/institutions is strictly prohibited.
 9. Parking of vehicles will be done at the designated places earmarked and managed by authorities of the religious places/institutions.
 10. Persons above 65 years of age, Persons with Co-Morbidities, Pregnant Women and Children below 10 years are advised not to visit the religious places/institutions in view of prevailing COVID-19 situation.
 11. The solemnisation of marriage and other social ceremonies wherever performed traditionally, are strictly prohibited inside the premises of the religious places/institutions and periphery area.
 12. All General Public/devotees shall enter into the religious places/institutions through the earmarked queue with barricade separately identified for "Male" & "Female" by maintaining physical distance as per COVID-19 guidelines from one another. There shall be separate entrance and exit doors with earmarking of circles on the floor in the queue for maintenance of physical distance.
 13. After "Darshan/Worship" , no general public/devotee shall be allowed to stay for longer period inside the premises of the religious places/institutions and shall have to vacate immediately to make the premises of the religious places/institutions free from commotion/congregation.
 14. It shall be the responsibility of the authorities of the religious places/institutions concerned to make all the arrangements as well as to ensure maintenance and observance of above guidelines/restrictions/ exemptions in letter and spirit for facilitating "Darshan/Worship" in disciplined manner in order to contain spread of COVID-19 virus.

Any violation shall attract penal actions and proceedings in accordance with the provisions U/s-51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act.,2005, the Epidemic Diseases Act,1897 and Section.188 of Indian Penal Code.

The above guidelines/exemption/restrictions will be reviewed periodically and revised guidelines/instructions will be issued from time to time to further facilitate "Darshan/Worship" by general public/devotees and also for management of COVID-19 pandemic.
