### Advertisement for Re-engagement of Retire Govt. Engineering Personnel (JEs/AEs) as OSDs in Different Blocks of Jajpur District

Applications are invited from interested eligible Retire Govt. Engineering Personnel (JEs/ AEs) to be engaged as OSD in different Blocks of Jajpur District & Zillaparishad, Jajpur with a consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs.20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand)only for implementation / execution of different developmental works including MGNREGS, PMAY and other Government Flagship Programme under PR & DW Department for a tenure of one year or till appointment of regular JEs/ AEs whichever is earlier. This re-engagement will be as per terms and conditions laid down in the guidelines relating to engagement of retired Government servants issued vide G.A. Department Resolution No.23750/dt.27.08.2014.

**Eligibility Criteria:-** The persons fulfilling the following criteria may apply for selection of OSD in different Blocks & Zillaparishad, Jajpur under PR & DW Department

1. Persons who have retired from Government Service (from the post of AE / JE) on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-engagement.
2. Persons against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated/pending or who have penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for re-engagement. In this regard an affidavit should be submitted with the application form that "no departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated/pending or penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five year against his/her".
3. The engagement shall be made in transparent manner through walk in interview at Zillaparishad, Jajpur.
4. The re-engagement of retirement Government JEs & AEs shall be pursuant to GA & PG Department Resolution No.23750/dt.27.08.2014 .
5. The re-engagement shall be for one year or till appointment of regular JEs/AEs whichever is earlier. While making the engagement the past track record of the incumbent shall be taken into consideration.
6. Re-employed officers shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants Conduct Rules, 1957 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.

**Appointment:-** The retire JEs/AEs will be appointed as OSD by the Collector-cum-CEO, Zillaparishad, Jajpur on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.

**Remuneration:-** The consolidated monthly remuneration shall be fixed to Rs.20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only per month with additional amount not exceeding of Rs.5,000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand) only per month towards conveyance allowance / mobile allowance etc.

**Removal :-** One month notice from either side shall be mandatory to resign / disengage of the OSDs.

**RESOLUTION**

The 27th August, 2014

**Subject: Comprehensive Guidelines relating to engagement of retired Government servants .**

The engagement of retired officers is at present being governed by the guidelines issued by the Government in General Administration Department Resolution No. 19637/Gen. dated the 30th June, 1999. According to these stipulations no proposal for re-engagement of any retiring/ retired functionary shall be considered in any circumstances except in certain specified cases as laid down in the said Resolution. The situation, in the meantime has undergone a drastic change. On account of delayed recruitment for various unavoidable reasons most of the Government establishments have inordinate workload on the remaining staff. On the basis of the above consideration certain Departments of Government have obtained orders of the Government in the past to engage retired Government servants temporarily on contractual basis for different spells with different remuneration and terms and conditions on obtaining concurrence of Finance Department wherein the prescribed upper age limit for engagement was not uniform

After careful consideration of the above situation and with a view to ensure a uniform principle it has been decided by the Government that the Departments of Government, while taking decisions for engagement of retired persons having professional excellence in Government assignments, shall follow the following principles to engage the retired Government servants on contractual basis.

**1. Applicability:—**

These guidelines shall apply to officers to be re-employed to such posts/services as may be decided by the Government from time to time.

**2. Eligibility Conditions: —**

- ✓ (i) Officers who have retired from Government service on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-employment.
- ✓ (ii) Officers against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated/ pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

**3. Selection Process: —**

- (i) Selection of persons will be made through open advertisement.
- (ii) There shall be a Selection Committee as may be decided by the appointing authority for the post/ posts required to be filled up by re-employment.

**4. Tenure, Terms and Conditions: —**

- (i) The re-employment shall be made *initially for a period of two years and can be extended for subsequent period of two years with spells of one year each* subject to satisfactory performance up to a *total period of four years not beyond the age of sixty-five years* of age in any case or till the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier.
- (ii) Re-employed officers will be entitled to pay and other allowances as determined by the Administrative Department/Appointing Authority with the concurrence of the Finance Department.
- (iii) Re-employed officers shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1957 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.
- (iv) The re-employment can be terminated at any time by the respective appointing authority due to unsatisfactory performance of any of the re-employed officer by giving one month

notice. On the contrary if any re-employed officer desires to resign he shall do so by giving one month's written notice to the competent authority.

**5. Retention of Government Quarters: --**

As provided in the Resolution No 19637/ Gen. dated the 30th June, 1999, during the period of the contract appointment the appointee may be accommodated in Government Quarters, subject to the availability, provided he pays normal rent as applicable to a Government servant occupying Government accommodation.

**6. Overriding effect: --**

The provisions of this resolution will supersede all previous executive instructions of the Government pertaining to re-employment of retired persons.


This Resolution shall come to force with effect from the date of publication in *Odisha Gazette*.

Sub- Re-engagement of retired Govt. Engineering personnel as OSD in the Districts.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the execution of different developmental works including MGNREGS, PMAY and other Govt. flagship programmes are hampering a lot due to large number of vacancies in the grade of JEs/AEs under PR Cadre of PR & DW Department. In view of the difficulties faced in the field level for implementation of different Schemes, Govt. have been pleased to decide that the retired Govt. Engineering Personnel (JEs/AEs) shall be re-engaged as OSDs till joining of regular JEs or until further orders whichever is earlier.

I would, therefore, request you to take necessary steps for re-engagement of retired Govt. Engineering Personnel (JEs/AEs) against the existing vacancies of the Districts as mentioned at Annexure-A with the following terms and conditions:

1. District shall ensure transparency in selection of OSDs through open Advertisement followed by walk-in-interview at ZP Level.
2. The re-engagement of retired Govt. JEs and AEs shall be pursuant to GA & PG Deptt. Resolution No.23750 dated 27.08.2014 and FD O.M. No.24533/F dated 29.09.2022 and subsequent modifications issued from time to time.
3. The re-engagement shall be for one year or appointment of regular JEs/AEs whichever is earlier. While making the engagement the past track record of the incumbent shall be taken in to consideration.

P.T.O

4. The consolidated monthly remuneration shall be fixed to Rs.20,000/- p.m. with additional amount not exceeding Rs.5000/- p.m towards conveyance allowance/mobile allowance etc.
5. The expenditure on payment of consolidated remuneration shall be met out of the Administrative fund available under different Scheme like MGNREGS, PMAY (G) etc. within the permissible limit prescribed under the guidelines.
6. The District Administration shall be responsible for their activities and performances and the payment of monthly remuneration shall be made on obtaining absentee statement from the concerned Controlling Authority.
7. One month notice from either side shall be mandatory to quit/disengage of the OSDs.
8. If any district requires more JEs beyond what has been allotted, they may submit a proposal to the Department for approval provided that no. allotted in this letter has been engaged.
